### **31.12 ELECTED MEMBERS REMUNERATION**

Elected members to Council shall be offered the maximum remuneration as determined by the Remuneration Authority each year. If an individual member elects to accept only part of the remuneration the balance available shall be distributed through the Communities Committee.

All elected members shall be entitled to claim all actual and reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of their functions and duties with reimbursement being made upon claim in accordance with Council's decision and the Remuneration Authority's approval.
