INFORMATION ON PUBLIC NOTIFICATION FOR GAMBLING VENUES

Part of the Council's Class 4 Gambling Venue Policy requires:

All applications for either a new gambling venue or an increase in the number of gaming machines at an existing Class 4 venue to more than the number operating at that venue on 22 September 2003, or more than the number previously consented to by Council, shall be twice publicly notified within an approved newspaper and/or community newsletter circulating within the district to which the application relates at least 7 days, but not more than 14 days apart.

The Council will place the two notices for advertising in the newspapers. The applicant will be responsible for meeting the costs of advertising and also for any further costs involved with the application. The decision will be made by full Council following a hearing of which the applicant and everybody who has made a written submission on the application will have the opportunity to be heard.

The application form is available from Council offices in Westport and Reefton and also on our website www.bullerdc.govt.nz . The form must be completed and lodged together with all required information and fee before the first advertisement is placed. The application will not be processed or considered until all information and the two notices in the newspaper have been completed.
