### 78.10 COMMON DRAINS

**Source:** Operations Committee meeting 12/12/91, p.7, item 4.3, (R5/17, S2/1).

1. That Council not maintain or declare as public drains any common drains not previously declared public drains.
2. That any person wishing to establish that a particular common drain is the responsibility of Council be required to demonstrate that Council has resolved to make the drain in question a public drain and that Council's public minutes be made available to them for that purpose.

### 78.11 WATER SUPPLIES - METERING OF LONG LINES

**Source:** Operations 13/5/93, page 13, item 4.11, (R5/17, W1/2).

1. That Council require all supplies to rural and rural/residential properties to be metered with existing unmetered supplies being metered at Council's cost and all new supplies being metered at the consumer's cost.
2. That backflow preventers be required to be installed on all rural and rural/residential properties where, in the Council's opinion, there is a likelihood of contaminated water being sucked back or syphoned into the main water supply. Furthermore, that all existing supplies that have not had

backflow preventers installed shall have them installed at Council's cost and all new supplies shall have them installed at the consumer's cost.

### 78.12 OLD SEWER CONNECTIONS

That where a section is served by a sewer connection to a Council main and a new building is to be erected requiring a sewer connection the owner shall either:

1. Prove by test, to the satisfaction of the Manager Operations, that the old connection allows no stormwater or ground water infiltration; or
2. Apply for a new service connection to the property at the applicants' cost.

Council will provide main extension at its cost, to within 30 metres of the property boundary where necessary to allow the operation of this policy.

### 78.13 SEPARATELY TITLED PROPERTIES

All separately titled properties are to be separately serviced to a Council or communal main at the time of subdivision, and where separate

household units are constructed on the same titled property, the property owner be advised that any future subdivision will require separate services.
