

## **100.1 TREES OVERHANGING FOOTPATHS**

**Source:** Operations, 13/11/03, item 11

- i)** That trees etc are not permitted to overhang on a footpath to any height less than 2.5 metres above the footpath level and are not permitted to encroach to such an extent that less than 1.5 metres of clear width is available for pedestrian traffic.
  
- ii)** That should property owners or occupiers fail to action requests, from Council, to remove lower or trim trees etc. which overhang or encroach onto a footpath from their property then Council shall, through its chairman or principal administrative officer and under the powers vested in it by the Local Government Act 1974, take steps to have the overhanging or encroaching trees etc. removed, lowered or trimmed as appropriate.
